Tabellion lets you sort and filter cases in a variety of ways, so you can always find the case you are looking for.

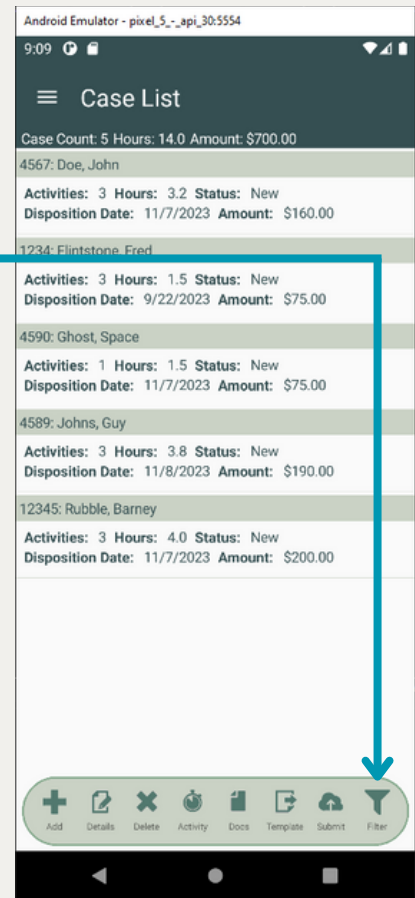

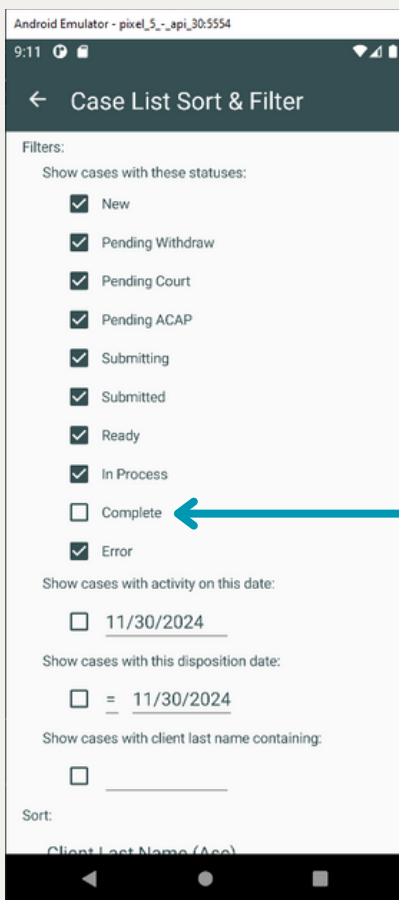

Feature Highlight: Sort and Filter

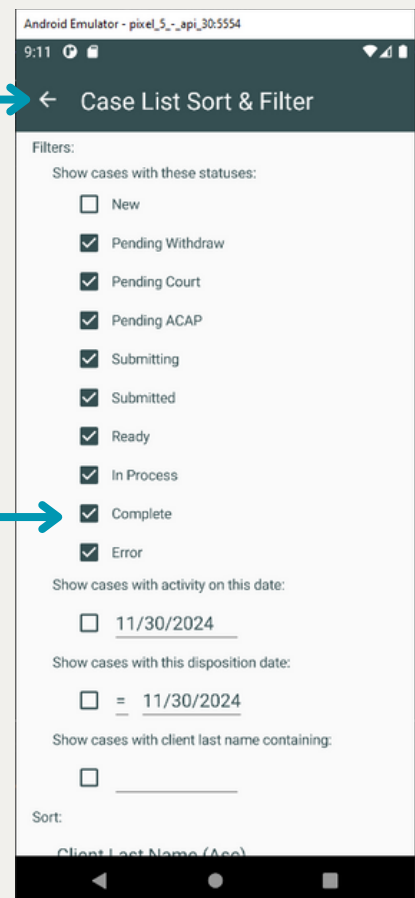
Tabellion provides robust sort and filter options for various scenarios. By default, cases that have been submitted to ACAP (with a status of Complete) are not displayed in the case list. To see completed cases, change sort and filter options, click the Filter button.



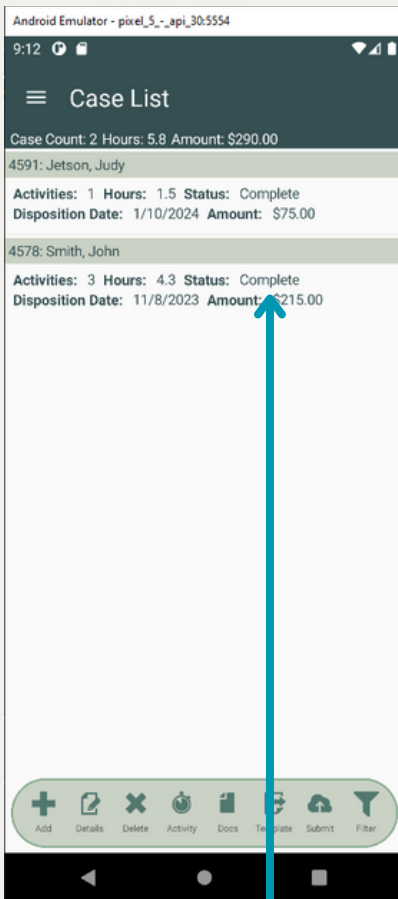
This takes you to the Sort & Filter options. As you can see, the Complete status is not selected.



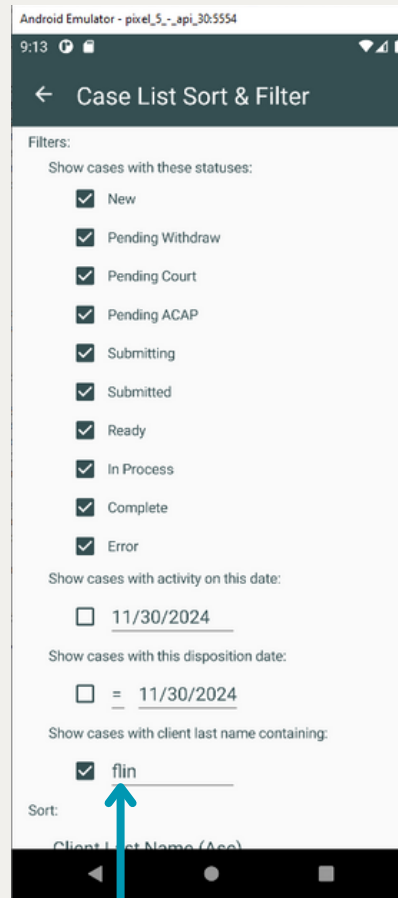
To show cases already submitted to ACAP, first uncheck New and check Complete. To apply the new options, hit the back button.



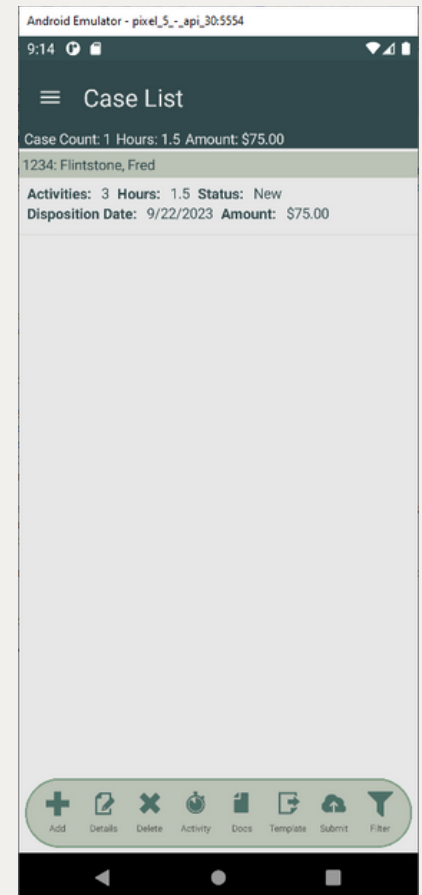
Feature Highlight: Sort and Filter



The list now includes cases in the Complete status while excluding cases in the New status.



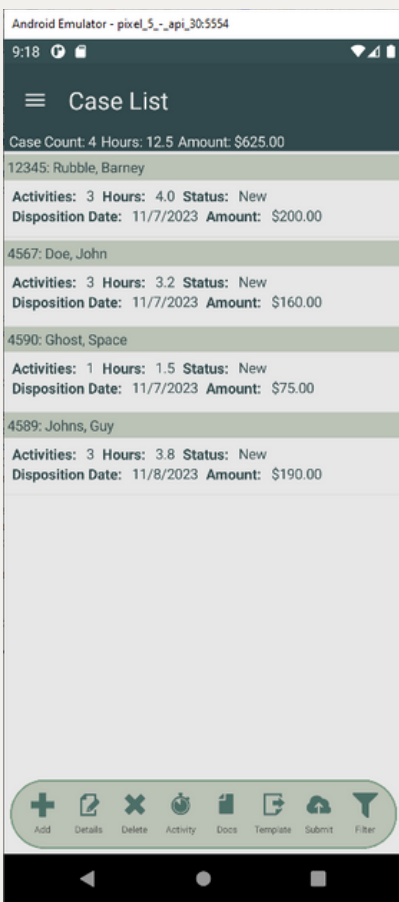
Another common scenario is to find cases by client last name. Here we are searching for Fred Flintstone, accomplished by entering a part of his last name.



The list now includes cases with clients whose last name contains *flin*.

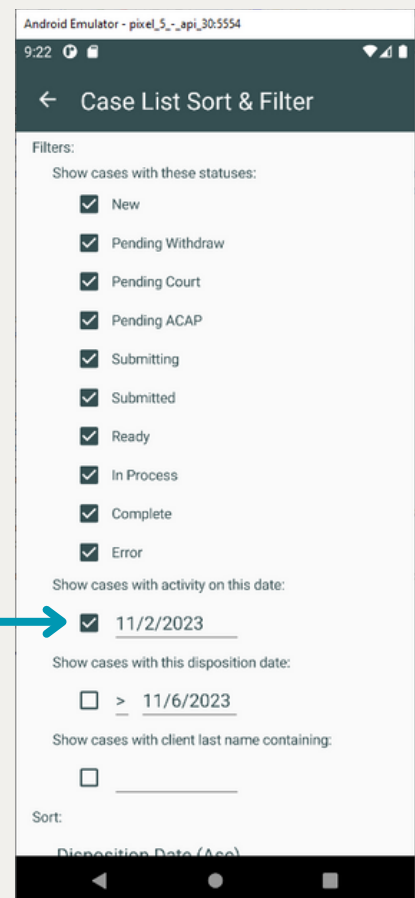
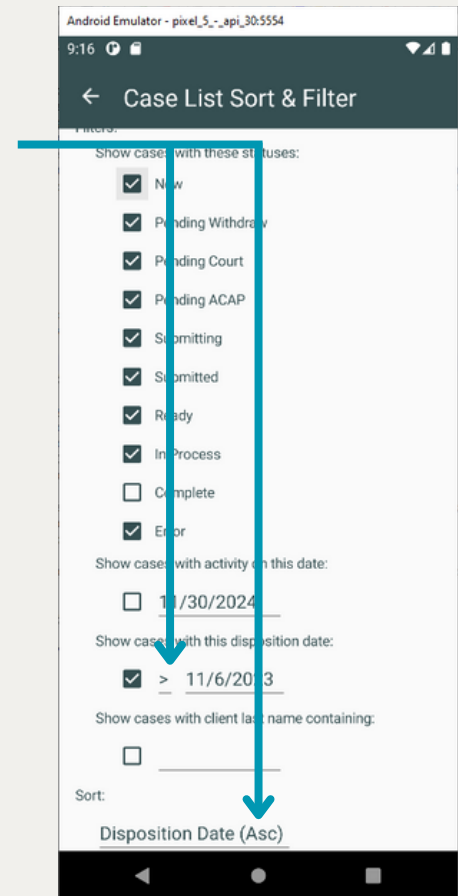
Feature Highlight: Sort and Filter

Another instance to use sort and filter is for finding upcoming case dates. For example, to see cases with upcoming court dates after 11/06/2023, enable the disposition date based filter, set the operator to greater than and the date to **11/06/2023**. Also, set the Sort option to **Disposition Date (Asc)**.

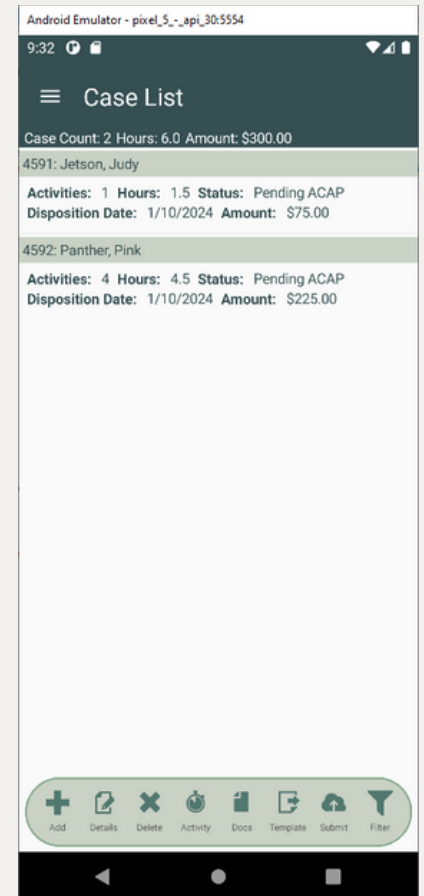
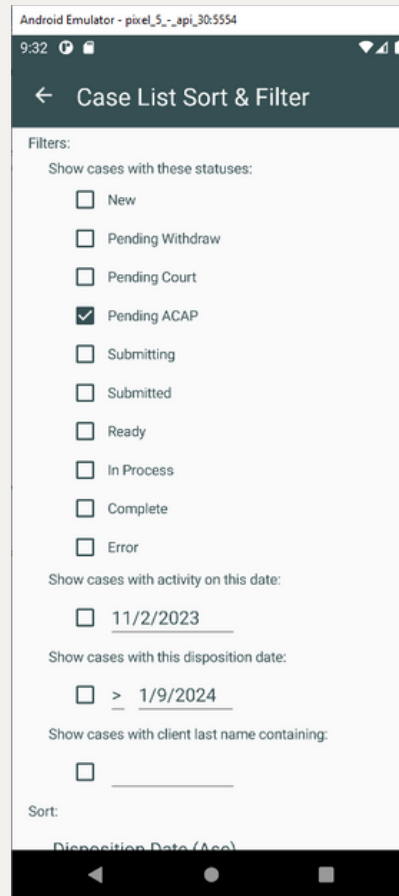
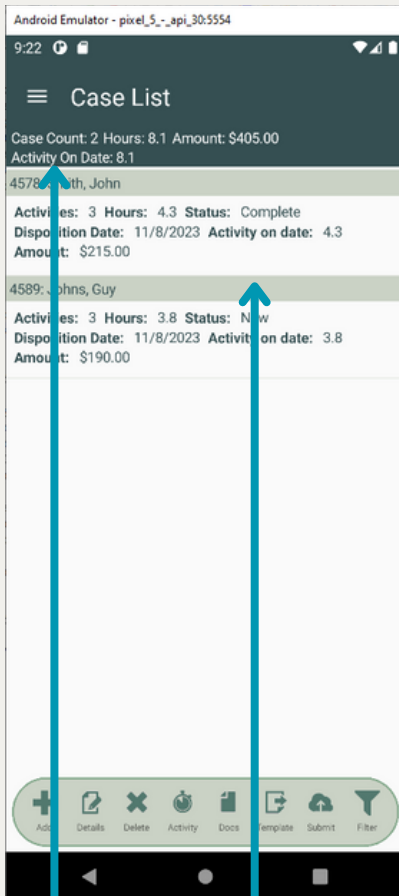


The list now includes cases with a disposition date greater than 11/06/2023. They are sorted in ascending order by disposition date. By keeping the disposition date of unresolved cases set to the next court date, this list gives you a calendar of upcoming cases and court dates.

Another use case is to show cases with activities on a particular date. In this example, the **activity on this date** option is checked and the date is set.



Feature Highlight: Sort and Filter



The list now includes only cases with activity on 11/2/2023. The Activity on Date field is displayed for each case and in the summary pane.

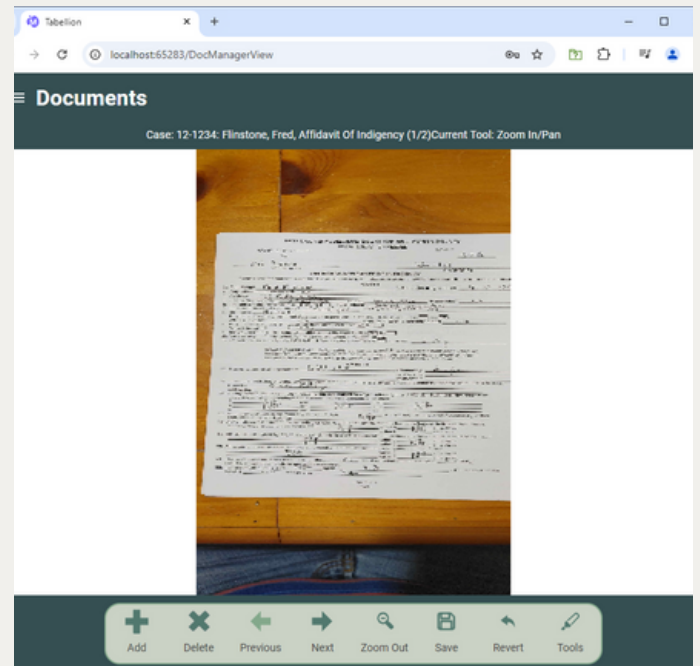
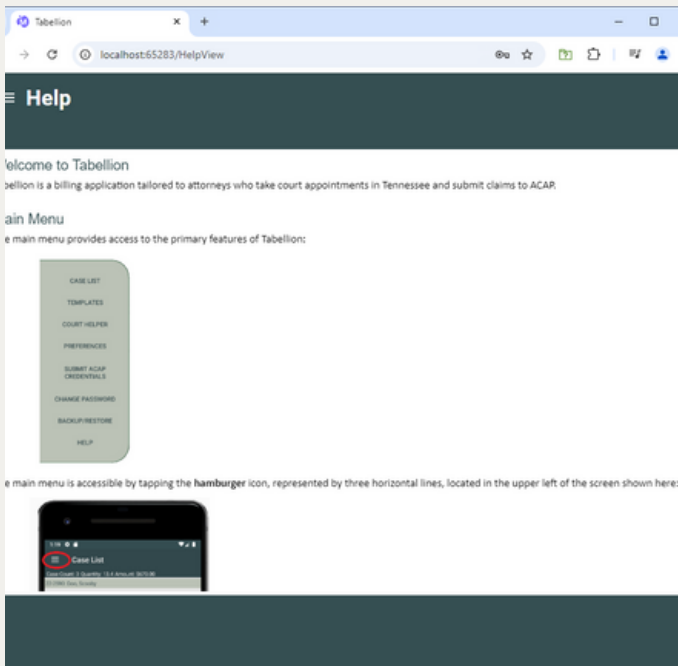
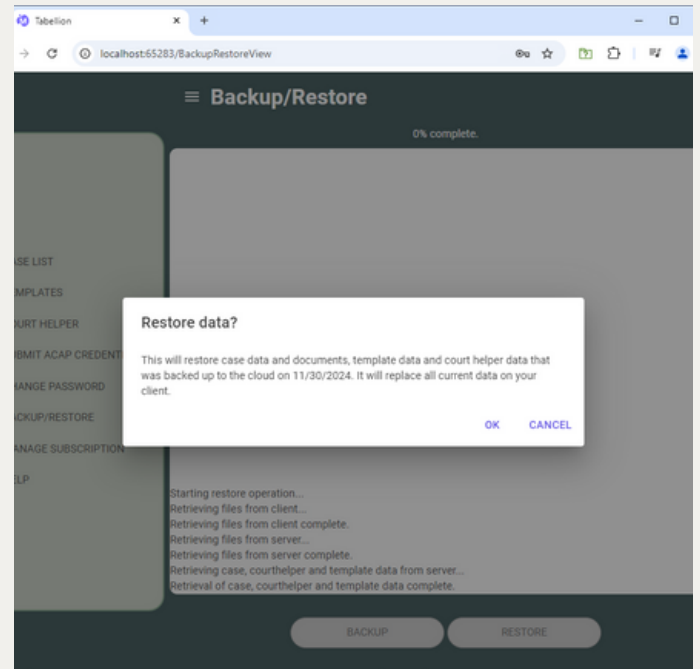
Finally, by setting cases which are being prepared for submission to ACAP to the status of Pending ACAP, those cases can be easily filtered.

The list is now limited to only cases in the Pending ACAP status. The Amount field in the summary pane can be used to easily reconcile the total billed amount with ACAP.

These are just a few of the useful applications of the sort and filter functionality in Tabellion.

Web App Progress

We continue working on the browser version of Tabellion. At this time, we have 27 out of 28 pages complete. That is 96 percent! We are currently working on Document Manager which is the last page but also the most complicated. After completion, we will enter a testing phase.
